- Nearly 55 percent said that having health benefits was more important than having higher wages.
- Over 93 percent of respondents use their direct deposit option when getting paid.
- Well over half (56.32 percent) said they were not confident their private data (such as Social Security number and address) would remain private if their paycheck were processed overseas.
